### Chief & Council Update January Band Meeting Highlights

**Hunting Safety:** Reminder to all band members that the use of high-powered rifles is not permitted in residential zones. Signs will be posted in the community.

#### **Claims and Trusts:**

- Council will meet with Canada on January 23rd to continue negotiations on the Dam Site Claim.
- Leadership will meet in January to discuss next steps of RHT Phase 2 litigation. A meeting will also occur in March with leadership and the federal Minister.
- New documentation has been secured to support the Boundary Claim, which is based on leagues vs. miles. Dokis is almost ready to submit the claim to Canada.
- There is one vacancy on the Board of Trustees for the Hydro Trust. Interested Band members are encouraged to submit a resume to Sue Greer or Chief Gerry.

#### **Public Works:**

- Council has approved the design for replacement of the first bridge the new design will be wider and straighten out the road leading up to the bridge.
- A new waste management plan will be implemented to address safety issues at the dump, promote recycling, and improve overall dump operations.

**New Hydro Line:** Dokis is working with Hwy 69 First Nations to ensure consultations occur with the developers of a new hydro line that will run through First Nations territories, from Barrie to Hanmer.


#### Family Day Winter Carnival


